Uline Arena 1140 Third St, NE

Architect: Antunovich Assoc. Built: 1941 Type: Mixed-Use Planned Redevelopment

Douglas Development is collaborating with Antunovich Associates to transform the historic Uline Arena building into 150,000 square feet of office space and 50,000 square feet of retail.
